

Alternatively, please arrange for an official copy of your examination results to be sent directly to the Registrar's Office by the examination board.
- You must achieve a minimum final admission average of 74% in all Standard XII courses with the following minimum final grades: 81% in Mathematics (Applied Mathematics is not accepted), and 81% in one other Standard XII course.
- Required documents must be submitted by July 11, 2023.
